

**In accordance with policies outlined by the Bishop of Austin, anyone wishing to celebrate a Sacrament must be in at least their second year of Faith Formation.**

- Children seeking **Baptism** who are 7 years or older and have no prior Faith Formation need to enroll in their grade level Faith Formation class and attend for one (1) year. During their second year of Faith Formation, they will join the RCIA Adapted for Children process. After successfully completing this process, they may celebrate Full-Initiation into the Catholic Church during the Easter Vigil.
- Children enrolling in **2nd grade** Faith Formation must be baptized Catholic and this must be their 2nd year of Faith Formation. If your child was **not** enrolled in 1st grade, please contact the Director of Elementary Faith Formation. The preparation of 1st Reconciliation and 1st Holy Communion is completed during the 2nd grade Faith Formation in class. A copy of their Baptismal Certificate must accompany registration form.
- **Children in the 3rd-8th Grade Faith Formation** must be baptized Catholic and this must be their 2nd year of Faith Formation. If your child has not been enrolled in Faith Formation you will enroll them in their grade level class and they will attend one (1) year of Faith Formation. In their 2nd year, they will join the late Sacrament Program. After successfully completing this program, they may celebrate their 1st Reconciliation, 1st Holy Communion and Confirmation in the Spring of their 2nd year. A copy of their Baptismal Certificate must accompany registration.
